High control is leveraging the strength of your personality or your position against the weaknesses of others in order to get them to meet your selfish agenda.


#### **2 Timothy 1:7**

Marital love can only blossom and grow when it envisions a hopeful future.




The goal of grace is always the other person... and their best interests.
