













"qavah", which also means "to wait." but "wait with a feeling of tension and expectation while you wait for something to happen".


















Realize that 99.99999% of your life will be spent in a completely different eternal age

Psalm 77:11- I will remember the deeds of the LORD; yes, I will remember your wonders of old.






Self talk – preach to yourself the goodness of God and what He promises for the future


