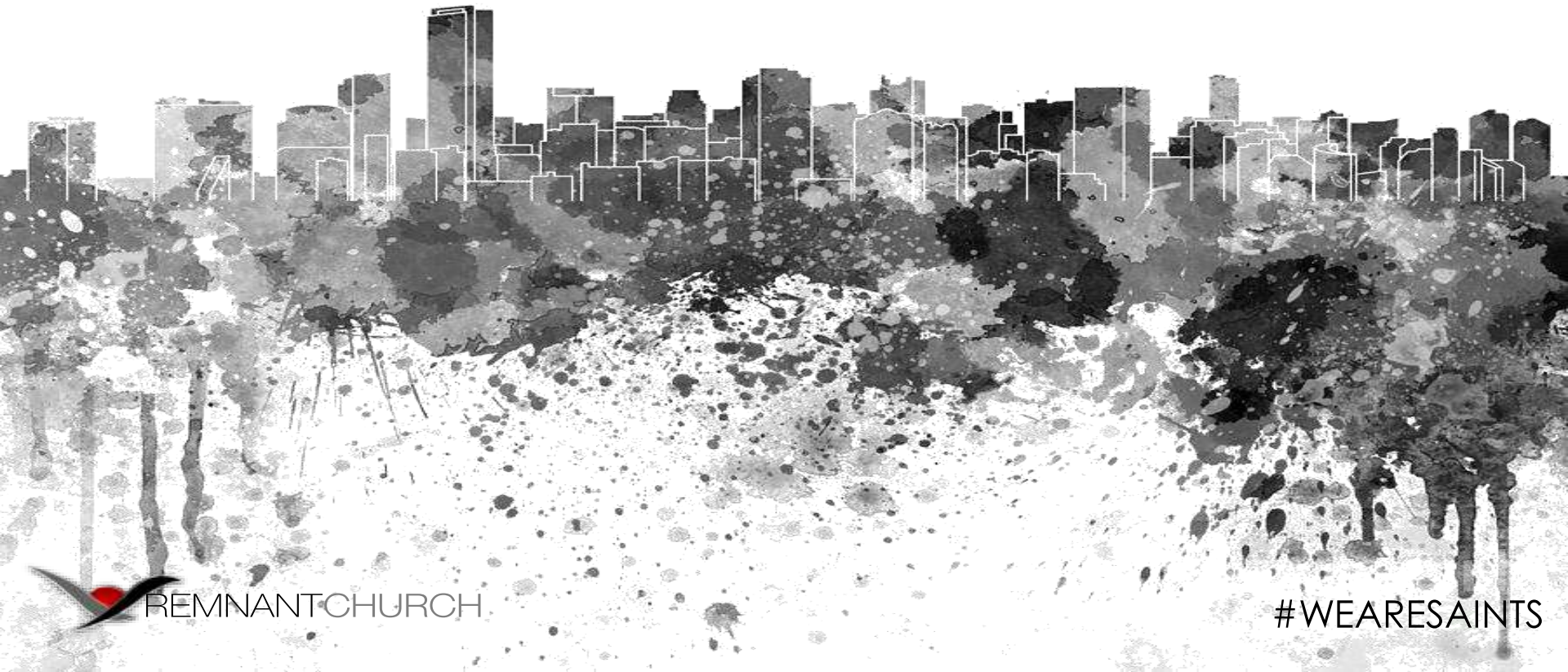


When Saints Fail

Romans 7:15(NLT)

Recognize Your Sin & Realize Its Weight

Romans 7:16-17(NLT)

"But if I know that what I am doing is wrong, this shows that I agree that the law is good. So I am not the one doing wrong: it is sin living in me that does it."

"Paul is not absolving himself of personal responsibility but emphasizing the power of sin."

Thanks be to God through
Jesus Christ our Lord!

***Paul understands
what sin does to us. It
makes us wretched
or miserable.***



Recognize Your Sin & Realize Its Weight

1 Timothy 1:15

"This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" - and I am the worst of them all."

He is the Worst of them all!?



Paul doesn't literally mean that he sins more than us or is a worse sinner than us. After all, he pleads with us to follow his lead.

This is him realizing the weight of his sin.



God Loves You, Saint & Sinner

Romans 5:8

God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

1 Tim. 1:13

Formerly I was a blasphemer, persecutor, and insolent opponent. But I received mercy because I had acted ignorantly in unbelief

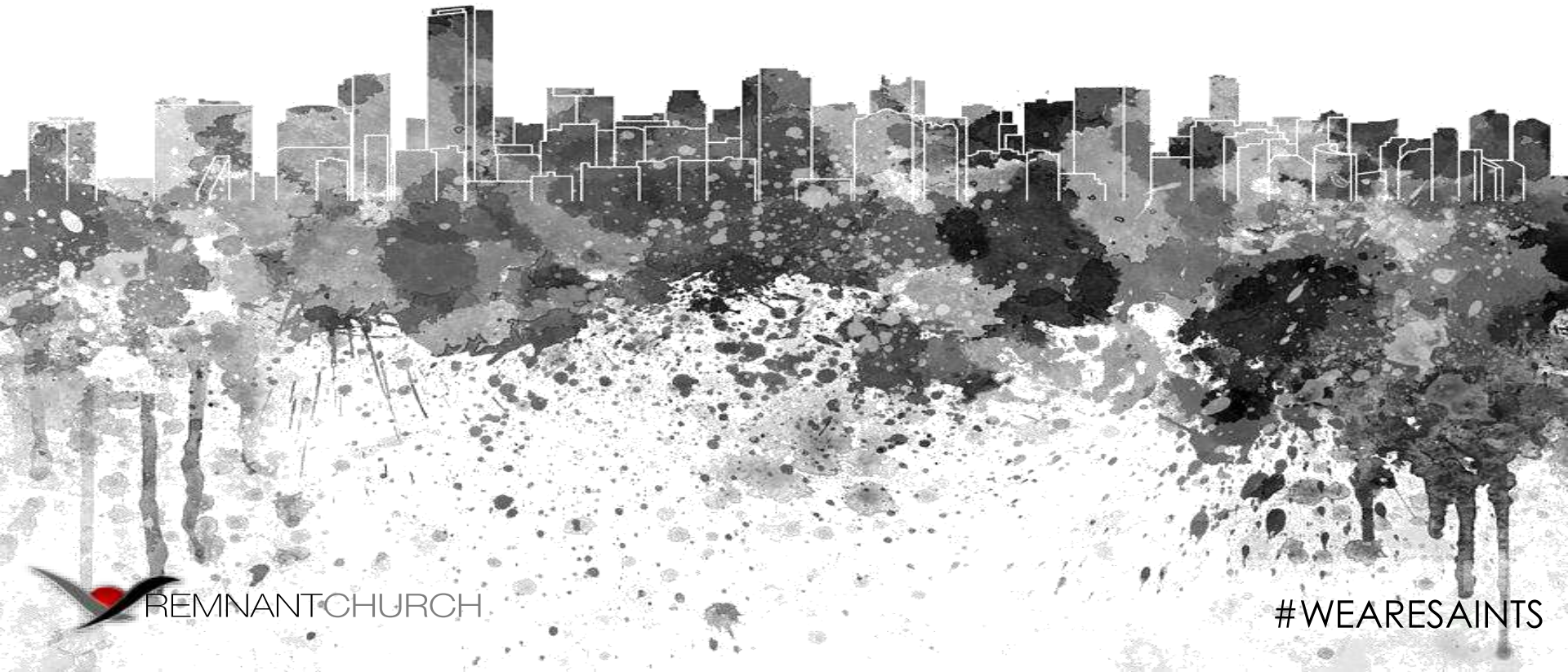
**When we
