James 5:7-12 Dear brothers and sisters, be patient as you wait for the Lord's return. Consider the farmers who patiently wait for the rains in the fall and in the spring. They eagerly look for the valuable harvest to ripen. 8 You, too, must be patient. Take courage, for the coming of the Lord is near. <sup>9</sup> Don't grumble about each other, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. For look—the Judge is

<sup>12</sup> But most of all, my brothers and sisters, never take an oath, by heaven or earth or anything else. Just say a simple yes or no, so that you will not sin and be condemned.

For the Scriptures say, "I will take revenge; I will pay them back," says the Lord. <sup>20</sup> Instead, "If your enemies are hungry, feed them. If they are thirsty, give them something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals of shame on their heads." 21 Don't let evil conquer you, but conquer evil by doing good.

1 Peter 2:18-23

You who are slaves must submit to your masters with all respect. Do what they tell you—not only if they are kind and reasonable, but even if they are cruel. 19 For God is pleased when, conscious of his will, you patiently endure unjust treatment. 20 Of course, you get no credit for being patient if you are beaten for doing wrong. But if you suffer for doing good and endure it patiently, God is pleased with you.

1 Peter 2:18-23

<sup>21</sup> For God called you to do good, even if it means suffering, just as Christ suffered for you. He is your example, and you must follow in his steps. <sup>22</sup> He never sinned, nor ever deceived anyone. <sup>23</sup> He did not retaliate when he was insulted, nor threaten revenge when he suffered. He left his case in the hands of God, who always judges fairly.

Human nature moves us to react in "justifiable anger"

Human wisdom calls for "standing up for my rights"

**James 5:8-9** 

You, too, must be patient. Take courage, for the coming of the Lord is near.

## We must have a willingness to let Him be our avenger

Luke 18:6-8

Then the Lord said, "Learn a lesson from this unjust judge. 7 Even he rendered a just decision in the end. So don't you think God will surely give justice to his chosen people who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off? 8 I tell you, he will grant justice to them quickly! But when the Son of Man returns, how many will he find on the earth who have faith?"

Luke 6:27-31

"But to you who are willing to listen, I say, love your enemies! Do good to those who hate you. <sup>28</sup> Bless those who curse you. Pray for those who hurt you. <sup>29</sup> If someone slaps you on one cheek, offer the other cheek also. Patient = "to suffer long"

A patient holding out under trial; a longprotracted restraint of the soul from yielding to passion, especially the passion of anger

The thought links itself naturally with that in the preceding verse: "the righteous does not resist"

#### DO NOT GRUMBLE

**James 5:9** 

Don't grumble about each other, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. For look—the Judge is standing at the door!

#### DO NOT GRUMBLE

#### **1 Corinthians 10:9-11**

Nor should we put Christ to the test, as some of them did and then died from snakebites. <sup>10</sup> And don't grumble as some of them did, and then were destroyed by the angel of death. <sup>11</sup> These things happened to them as examples for us. They were written down to warn us who live at the end of the age.

DO NOT GRUMBLE

The same Lord who will judge those who oppress others will judge those who murmur and grumble!

#### **DON'T MAKE RASH PROMISES**

**Ecclesiastes 5:1-7** 

As you enter the house of God, keep your ears open and your mouth shut. It is evil to make mindless offerings to God. <sup>2</sup> Don't make rash promises, and don't be hasty in bringing matters before God. After all, God is in heaven, and you are here on earth. So let your words be few.

<sup>3</sup> Too much activity gives you restless dreams;

#### **DON'T MAKE RASH PROMISES**

Ecclesiastes 5:1-7 too many words make you a fool.

<sup>4</sup> When you make a promise to God, don't delay in following through, for God takes no pleasure in fools. Keep all the promises you make to him. <sup>5</sup> It is better to say nothing than to make a promise and not keep it. <sup>6</sup> Don't let your mouth make you sin. And don't defend yourself by telling the Temple messenger that the promise

**Ecclesiastes 5:1-7** 

God angry, and he might wipe out everything you have achieved.

<sup>7</sup> Talk is cheap, like daydreams and other useless activities. Fear God instead.

#### **DON'T MAKE RASH PROMISES**

Matthew 5:33-37

"You have also heard that our ancestors were told, 'You must not break your vows; you must carry out the vows you make to the Lord.' <sup>34</sup> But I say, do not make any vows! Do not say, 'By heaven!' because heaven is God's throne. <sup>35</sup> And do not say, 'By the earth!' because the earth is his footstool. And do not say, 'By Jerusalem!' for Jerusalem is the city of the

#### **DON'T MAKE RASH PROMISES**

Matthew 5:33-37 for you can't turn one hair white or black. <sup>37</sup> Just say a simple, 'Yes, I will,' or 'No, I won't.' Anything beyond this is from the evil one.

#### **DON'T MAKE RASH PROMISES**

Matthew 23:16-22

Blind guides! What sorrow awaits you! For you say that it means nothing to swear 'by God's Temple,' but that it is binding to swear 'by the gold in the Temple.' <sup>17</sup> Blind fools! Which is more important—the gold or the Temple that makes the gold sacred? <sup>18</sup> And you say that to swear 'by the altar' is not binding, but to swear 'by the gifts on the altar' is binding. <sup>19</sup> How

Matthew 23:16-22

blind! For which is more important—the gift on the altar or the altar that makes the gift sacred? <sup>20</sup> When you swear 'by the altar,' you are swearing by it and by everything on it. 21 And when you swear 'by the Temple,' you are swearing by it and by God, who lives in it. 22 And when you swear 'by heaven,' you are swearing by the throne of God and by God, who sits on the throne.

**DON'T MAKE RASH PROMISES** 

The solution is to refrain from oaths altogether, and simply stand by your word.

**PRAY** 

James 5:13
Are any of you suffering hardships? You should pray. Are any of you happy? You should sing praises.

James 5:4
