## James 5:13-18

<sup>13</sup>Is any one of you in trouble? He should pray. Is anyone happy? Let him sing songs of praise. 14 Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord. <sup>15</sup>And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up. James 5:13-18 he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops.

James 5:13-18 (The Message) Are you hurting? Pray. Do you feel great? Sing. Are you sick? Call the church leaders together to pray and anoint you with oil in the name of the Master. Believing-prayer will heal you, and Jesus will put you on your feet. And if you've sinned, you'll be forgiven—healed inside and out.

James 5:13-18 (The Message) Make this your common practice: Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you can live together whole and healed. The prayer of a person living right with God is something powerful to be reckoned with. Elijah, for instance, human just like us, prayed hard that it wouldn't rain,

James 5:13-18 (The Message) and it didn't—not a drop for three and a half years. Then he prayed that it would rain, and it did. The showers came and everything started growing again.

The Prayer of Healing and Help

James 5:14-15

The Prayer of Confession and Community

**James 5:16** 

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.

The Prayer of Confession and Community

When you pray for someone you will find it very difficult to maintain a division, because real prayer requires real humility.

The Prayer of Power and Purpose

James 5:16-18

Keep Praying

1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing.

Keep Praying

If God isn't worthy of prayer in the good times why would you search Him out in the bad times?

Keep Praying

Prayer is to be persistent, steady, daily, not just a distress flare.

Our Prayers Get Answered

Matthew 7:8

For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it shall be opened

Prayer will always get answered.
