


WE NEED TO ACCEPT

God is not only above us, but he's also with us.












When Joseph woke up, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded and took Mary as his wife.

"Don't be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favor with God! 31 You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus.




