Her Maturity


1 Peter 3:1-2

Her commitment to the Lord, and desire to see her husband saved, guides her conversation and attitude toward her husband.

This is the God given order for the home. A faithful wife, following her husband's leadership, brings honor to the Lord.






If the Lord rules our lives and homes, then we all will possess a desire to live in a way that pleases Him, even if that requires us to lay aside personal preferences and desires.
