






EVALUATE VOUR SUFFERING

EVALUATE YOUR SUFFERING

2 Thessalonians 1:5-9

EVALUATE VOUR SUFFERING

2 Thessalonians 1:5-9 appears from heaven. He will come with his mighty angels, 8 in flaming fire, bringing judgment on those who don't know God and on those who refuse to obey the Good News of our Lord Jesus. 9 They will be punished with eternal destruction, forever separated from the Lord and from his glorious power.



EVALUATE YOUR SUFFERING

Since God is granting them the grace to endure, He is clearly on their side and is working to make them worthy for entrance into the kingdom of God.
