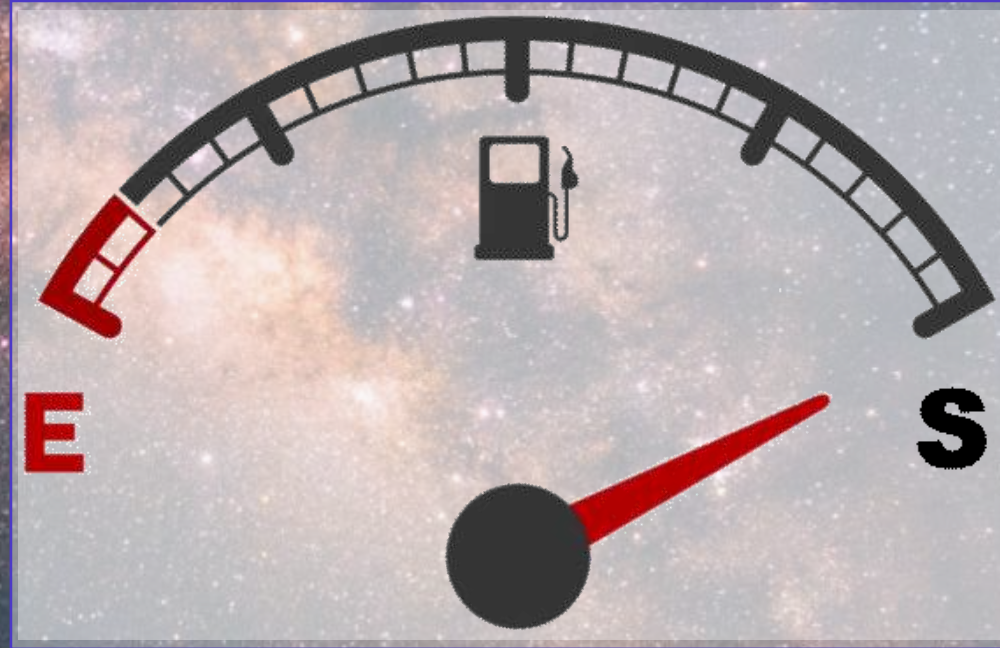
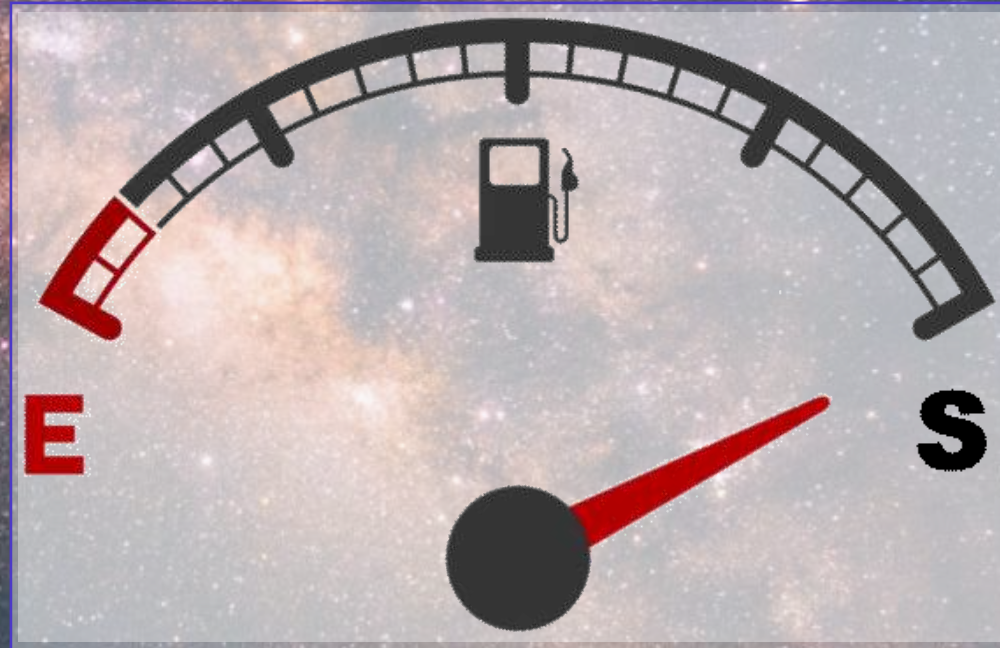

## **Matthew 5:27-32**

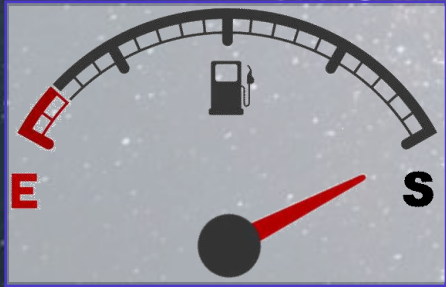

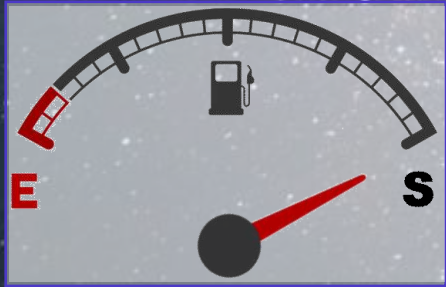
**Job 31:1**

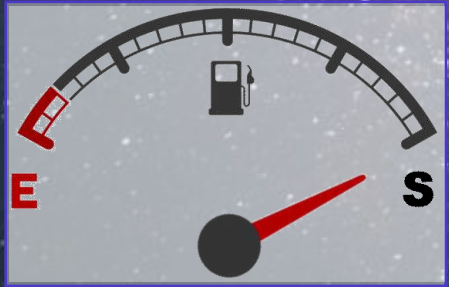
**"I made a covenant with my eyes not to look with lust at a young woman."**

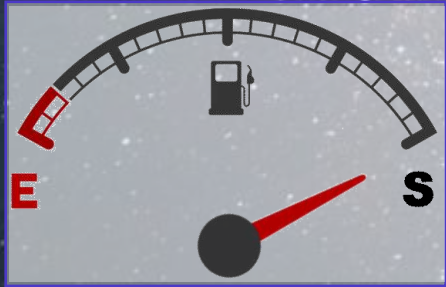

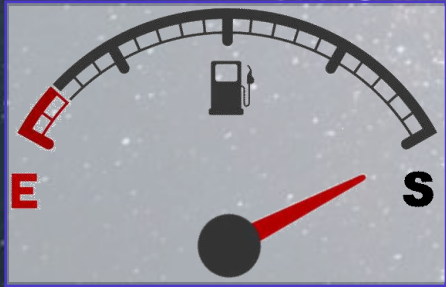
